Chapter 2

Geometric Mark



Always use bright body and dark background. Prefer using white body and black background.

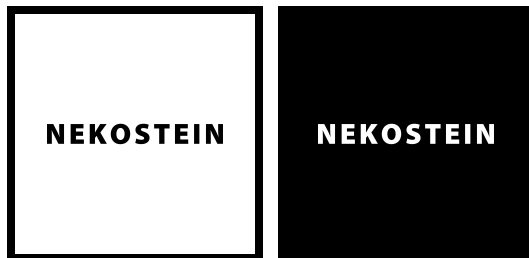
You would generally use the provided “Nekostein-avatar.white_black.png” file. It is great for most scenarios, including square avatar, circle avatar, icon grid, and free canvas.

You may also play with the “Nekostein-geologo.white_null.svg” file in your own vector editor to apply custom effects.

For your convenience, if you need a rounded square, you may use the provided file “Nekostein-avatar.white_black.rounded.png”.

Chapter 3

Word Mark



Our word mark uses the **Myriad Pro** font (the Black face) with a 10% letter spacing. See ImageMagick documentation for explanations on “-pointsize” and “-kerning”. We use the two parameters (“-pointsize 700 -kerning 70”) to create the word mark PNG.

You would generally use the provided “Nekosteин-logo.white.png” file.

Chapter 4

Logo Combinations

4.1 Vertical Combination



When a combination is needed, the vertical combination is often a nice choice. You may use the “Nekostein-logocombV.white.png” file over dark background.

Also, the “Nekostein-logocombV-padded.white_black.png” file includes internal padding and black background. You may use this image over bright background.

4.2 Horizontal Combination



The horizontal combination may fit small-size scenarios, e.g. listing sponsors at the bottom of a poster. You may use the “Nekostein-logocombH.*.png” files according to your background color.

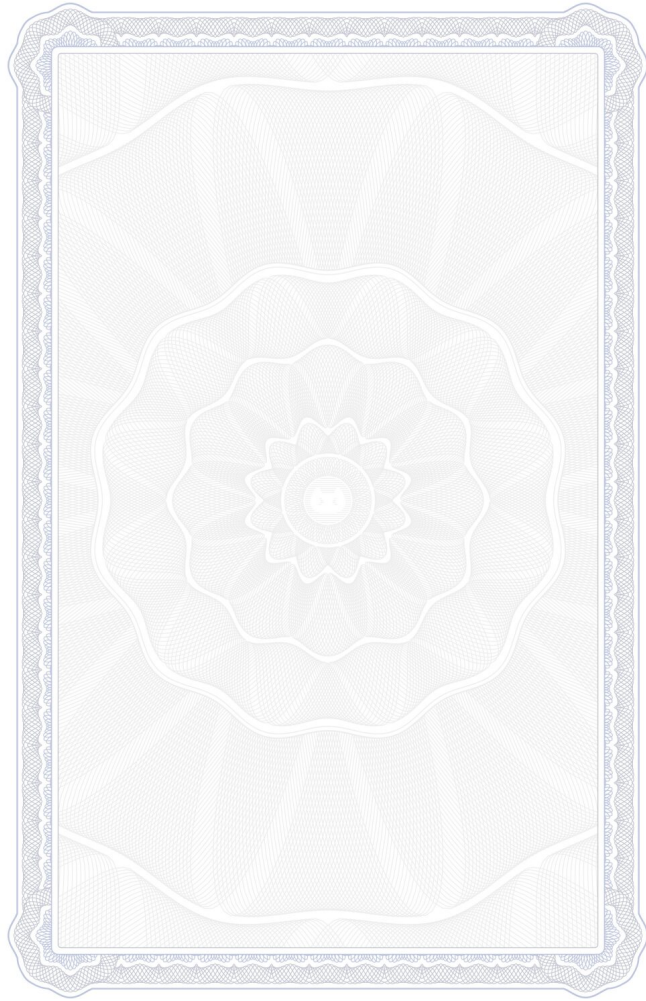
Guilloche Patterns

We have several guilloche patterns to be used. To reduce the size of the distributed ZIP archive, we only include the SVG versions.

You can find them in “_dist/libvi/patterns”.

To generate the PNG versions, run the following command.

```
./_dist/libvi/distutils/patternpng.sh
```

6.1 NekstFair Logo



The logo of NekstFair uses Myriad Pro and Bowlby One fonts.

The “nekstfair-logo.*.trim.png” files may be used in simple black-and-white environments. Also, you may apply custom colors for the “outline” and the “hole” to accommodate colorful/monochrome scenes.
